

# Safeguarding

## **Keeping children safe in education is our priority.**

At Huntley C of E we respect our children and hope to provide them with an atmosphere that encourages all children to do their best. The health, safety and welfare of our children are of paramount importance to us. We know they have the right to protection, regardless of age, gender, race, religion, culture or disability. They have a right to be safe in school.

We respect learner and staff diversity, encourages freedom and openness and promotes the learner voice.

## **In addition..**

In line with the *PREVENT duty* we will ensure that all staff and governors are trained, informed, recognise vulnerability and mitigate the risks of radicalisation and extremism. We are currently in the process of discussing the impact on this on our school and our policies and producing an action plan to mitigate identified risks and ensure the curriculum embeds British Values, teaching our staff, children and visitors to be tolerant and have respect for all faiths within our multi-cultural society.

**In order to keep our children safe in school we would like to remind parents and visitors to Huntley CE Primary School of the following rules:**

### **During the day**

All adults (including parents, visitors and volunteers) should sign in at the school office before visiting a member of staff or a classroom. They will then be issued a visitors' badge and information on safeguarding at Huntley CE Primary School.

Items belonging to children, such as homework, PE kits, musical instruments, should be left at the School Office where staff will make sure they are taken on to your child.

Adults without authorisation to be on school premises will need to be escorted by a member of staff

### **After school**

Parents must pick up their children from the front of school, near the main reception. (excepting Rising Fives who can be collected by Class Stream gate.

The playground will be locked at 4.30pm each day. If you need to collect a child from an after school club, this should happen from where the club takes place, where the person in charge of the club will release your child into your safekeeping. E.g. Playground, Field, Main reception area.
