Our topic this term is
Modern Europe

Topic: We will travel around Europe learning about the cultures, physical features, important landmarks, climate and weather of these different countries! We will develop our atlas skills to help us research these places. We will also create maps using symbols and keys to find out more about these countries. We will compare the temperature in the UK to different parts of Russia.

Science: Y2 will learn about materials with Y1. Y3 will learn about states of matter with Y4. Children will have the opportunity to explore these topics using a range of skills, such as: comparative and fair testing, observing, comparing, identifying and researching using sources.

DT: We will put our learning of healthy diets to use by preparing a meal. We will use a range of cooking skills to make pasta and sauce! Delicious!

Music: We will continue our theme of traditional tales by listening to orchestral music based on many of these stories. Children will learn about the parts of an orchestra, evaluate pieces of music and use instruments to perform a story.

PE: Class River will have PE on Mondays and Fridays please come into school in kit on these days.



English:

Numeracy:

Year 2

- Number and place value of numbers up to 100.
- Counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 and comparing 2 digit numbers.

Year 3

- Number and place value of numbers up to 1000.
- Counting in multiples of 4, 8 and 50. Find 10 and 100 more/less than a given number. Comparing 3 digit numbers.
